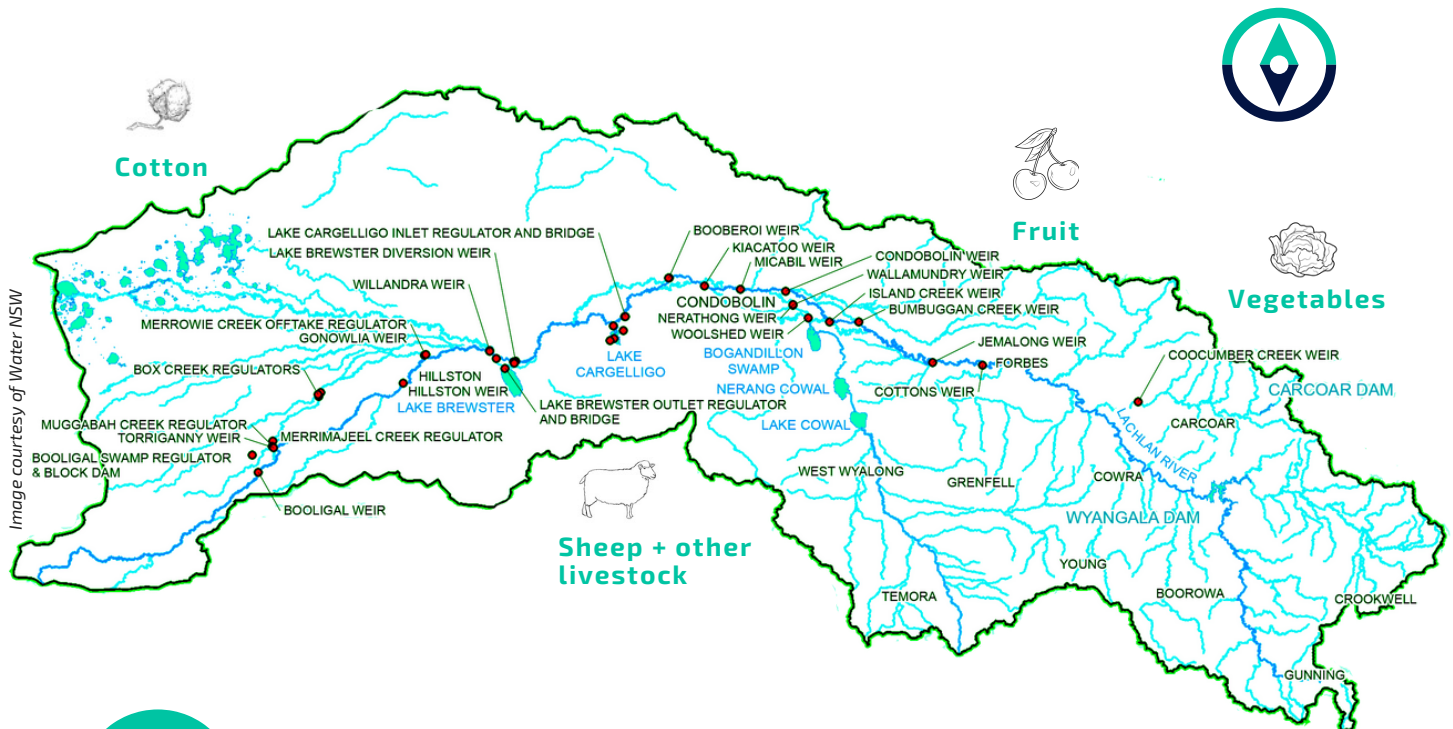


THE LACHLAN VALLEY IS A FOOD & FIBRE PRODUCING REGION

THE LACHLAN VALLEY

covers an area of 84,700 km², running from Crookwell and Gunning in the east to Oxley and Ivanhoe in the west. The Lachlan River rises near Yass and flows for approximately 1450 km to the Great Cumbung Swamp, northwest of Hay.
